Instructions for executing Deeds

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The example below shows how a deed should be executed, each party signing in the presence of a witness who should add his or her name, address and occupation as shown. Witnesses should be adults unrelated to the person signing the deed and who have no interest in the transaction. After signing the deed should be returned to us UNDATED.
